



## Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Checklist American Aviation Flight Academy

1. Register with TSA at [www.flightschoolcandidates.gov](http://www.flightschoolcandidates.gov) and submit a Category III Alien Flight Student Program (AFSP) Flight Training Request Application. Flight Training Requests for the current course you will be enrolling in should be submitted two months prior to arrival to avoid delays in training.

2. Once American Aviation Flight Academy verifies all of the Enrollment requirements have been met through Pasco-Hernando State College, we will review and acknowledge the TSA training request.
3. The applicant must pay the TSA fee for the submitted training request after American Aviation Flight Academy acknowledges the request. The request will start processing if all of the applicant's information is correct.
4. All applicants must be fingerprinted\* upon receiving TSA fingerprint instructions. To use a National Air Transportation Association (NATA) certified fingerprint collector you can find locations and information at [https://secure.natacs.aero/afsp/find\\_location.asp](https://secure.natacs.aero/afsp/find_location.asp). The fees for Collection, Shipping and Processing are listed on the NATA website.
